Four conversation themes

1. Seven weeks became seven years: a family separated by war.
2. The life after reunion: rebuilding home and family.

4. Listening across generations: preserving a loved one's story.

A manageable, thoughtful format

Suggested: 30 minutes with a moderator, followed by 15 minutes of audience Q&A. A shorter virtual visit may suit a reading group. Each invitation is considered individually.
